

A dream fulfilled A thousand lives transformed...

Sometimes it takes a terrible tragedy to help us discover the true strength of our spirit...and the true purpose of our lives. The story of the Indian Spinal Injuries Centre, is really the story of one man's journey of faith...of accomplishing an almost impossible mission...of completely dedicating his life to help transform the lives of others...

Major Ahluwalia was just 26 years old when he climbed the world's highest peak, Mount Everest. Tragically just a few months later, he was wounded in the Indo-Pak war which resulted in his confinement to the



wheelchair. It was a tragedy that would have destroyed most people. Though he nearly lost his life, he never lost his courage or his fighting spirit. "Life is all about conquering the other summit - the Summit of the Mind," he says even today.

To his dismay, Major Ahluwalia discovered that there were no specialized hospitals for people with spinal injured in India. Determined to rebuild his life, he finally travelled to the UK, to undergo intensive rehabilitation at the Stoke Mandeville

Hospital. It was an experience that totally transformed him. He realized that though he himself had been lucky to get expert care, millions of Indians were not so fortunate and were forced to lead marginalized lives. It became his life's mission to help others like him and he determined to set up a similar hospital in India.


In the early 1990s, Major Ahluwalia's dream project began to take shape, when the Government of India gave him financial grant. To ensure the highest standards, he sought collaboration with leading institutes around the world. Impressed with his vision, the Government of Italy invested

US \$ 10 million in the project - the largest ever Italian collaboration with any country in this sector. The Indian Spinal Injuries Centre (ISIC) was a true landmark, not only in India, but in the whole of Asia.


Our Mission

It also has Research Collaboration with the Bio-Medical Scientific Park of San Raffaelle Hospital, Milan, Italy - a network of various research agencies, run by Nobel Laureates.

ISIC is committed to bring the benefits of the latest advances in scientific research to its patients. One of the most promising new areas in breakthrough medical technology is the use of embryonic stem cells. They hold special promise in the repair of nerve and muscular tissue.

The driving force behind the revolution in spinal injury management in India, ISIC has taken the lead in organizing international seminars and conferences and provide a forum for the exchange of knowledge, new ideas and research findings in disability care. It recently hosted the International Spine & Spinal Injuries Conference on "Complications in Spinal Cord Injury & Spine Surgery", under the patronage of the International Spinal Cord Society.


Dr Mukherjee has been working for the welfare of the disabled for more than four decades. After completion of Masters in Surgery in Orthopaedics he joined the Oxford University as a Berry Scholar and completed his doctorate. He was former Medical Advisor to the World Health Organisation and Fellow of the Academy of Medical Sciences. He has been Director General of Health Services, Government of India, Secretary General of the Indian Red Cross and the Chief of the Medical Council of India.

At the cutting edge of Surgical Technology



As part of our ongoing commitment to offer the most advanced treatment to our patients, we continue to collaborate with leading medical institutes worldwide and keep up-to-date with breakthroughs in surgical technology. We constantly share our knowledge with other institutions and the medical profession, through an exchange program with demonstrations of live surgeries. There have often been cases when doctors from overseas come to observe our techniques and then transfer the knowledge to their own countries.

'The Indian Spinal Injuries Centre is one of just 3 institutions in India that has the specialized facilities to do disc replacement. We have successfully carried out the first triple replacement of cervical discs in India. Made of titanium, with a polyurethane gel, the discs are completely biocompatible. We are currently doing cervical disc replacement and plan to start lumbar disc replacement soon. I work closely with my colleagues around the globe and we have been able to achieve remarkable success in pain management and restoring normal mobility."








"Spinal injury management is the most complex, because it requires a multi-disciplinary team. Unfortunately it is also the most common amongst the lower income groups, who are often involved in physical labour and most likely to suffer from injuries.

ISIC has the largest number of trained paramedics, who have specialized from Institutes in Australia, Switzerland, England as well as San Raffaelle Hospital in Italy.

ISIC offers complete facilities for physiotherapy, including the largest solar heated hydrotherapy unit in Asia, with a 350 sqm. temperature controlled pool and a system of healing through Hot Jet Massage and Color Therapy.

It has Occupational Therapy with a Computer Centre for training patients to lead a productive, self-reliant life. It also offers Psychological and Spiritual Counseling for patients and their families.

We have had remarkable success in the treatment of paralysis, neurological strokes, post fracture complications, arthritis, spondylitis and backaches. Our aim is to reduce the patient's dependence on drugs, relieve pain, improve mobility, strengthen muscles and enhance self-reliance.

Sports & Recreation

We try to help our patients lead as joyful and fulfilled a life as possible. Team sports not only provide an opportunity to bond with other patients, but are also a great activity for the whole family. We have complete facilities for both outdoor and indoor sports. The entire hospital is barrier-free, to allow patients on wheelchairs to move around easily and independently.
